Requirements for Ladd-Pebbles Stadium

Parking (Map Attached)

- Graduates will enter the stadium parking lot from the West Main Gate, located on the north (Virginia Street) side of the stadium.
- Guests will enter the stadium parking lot from the East Main Gate or the West Main Gate, both located on the north (Virginia Street) side of the stadium.
- The gate located in the southwest corner (Lott Street) of the parking lot will be utilized as an exit only.
- MCPSS (Athletics and ROTC) will direct cars to appropriate parking areas.

Tickets

- Each graduate will receive ten (10) MCPSS tickets to the ceremony.
- No one will be allowed into the stadium without going through security checks and without a VALID MCPSS issued ticket.

Stadium Entrance

- A total of three (3) gates will also be utilized for entry into the stadium. Those are Gate 1-W (handicap access only) and Gates 2-W and 3-W for general admission
- Gates will be open one hour before each ceremony begins.
- **Masks are recommended but not required for spectators.**
- **Only clear bags and bottled water will be allowed into stadium.**
- **Umbrellas will be permitted.**
- **All other stadium guidelines will be strictly enforced.**

Seating

- All seating will be on a first-come, first-served basis, except for handicap seating. ~~Handicap~~ seating will be **required** to sit in designated seating areas.
- Families of ten (10) are to sit together. **No more than ten individuals are to be seated in one area.**
- Each family must be three feet apart from other families.
- No one will be allowed to sit where red tape has been placed on the bleachers to adhere to social distancing requirements. **No one will be allowed to sit in any area marked in red.**
- Ticketholder wheelchair guests will be directed to the wheelchair-accessible area and may be accompanied by one ticket-holding guest. No one will be allowed into the stadium without going through security checks and without a VALID MCPSS issued ticket.
