

No student shall be denied enrollment in the Webster County School System for declining to provide his or her Social Security Number or for declining to apply for such a number.

The Superintendent shall insure that reasonable and sufficient public notice is given each year, in English and any other language prevalent in the school district, of the information required for students who will enter school in Webster County School System. Such public notice shall include the statement above.

The Superintendent shall establish procedures whereby:

1. At the time of initial enrollment or at the beginning of the school year for a student already enrolled but who has not provided the school system with a Social Security number, and in a language appropriate for the parent, guardian, student or person enrolling the student:
 - (a) A Social Security Number is requested;
 - (b) The purpose for which the Social Security Number shall be used is stated; and,
 - (c) It is made clear that providing the Social Security number is voluntary.
2. The appropriate form is provided for an individual to sign stating that he or she does not wish to provide the Social Security number.
3. Student Social Security Numbers are treated in the same confidential manner as all other records and in accordance with the Federal Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) of 1974.
4. A temporary number is assigned to a student who is applying for a Social Security Number, or a permanent student identification number is assigned if a Social Security Number will not be provided.
