

Attention parents,

The Mobile County Public School System has created new computer usernames for all students.

The new student username is a component of our transition to the district wide Microsoft Office 365 platform.

Students will use their new MCPSS credentials to login to district computers and to access the miDevice wireless network for personal devices.

We will no longer use the “@mcpssstu.org” username or email address. This will replace student email with a completely new account in Office 365!

User ID: First, middle, and last initial, followed by the last 6 digits of the state ID number **@stu.mcpss.com**

Example: Joe Moore Smith, Student # 123456789

User ID: jms456789@stu.mcpss.com

*If student has multiple middle names, the FIRST middle name will be the initial used.

Password: First and last initial (first being capitalized) followed by the birthday

Example: Joe Moore Smith, February 17, 2009

Password: Js02172009

***Upon logging in using the password from the example above, only secondary students in grades 6-12 will be prompted to reset their password just as they have over the past few years. The new password requirement will be 10 characters and you must use 3 of the 4 following: capital, lower case, number, symbol. Once Joe Moore Smith, in the above example, logs in using his User ID and Password, he will be prompted to reset his password.

Example: Old Password – Js02172009

Example: New Password – Js02172009!
