### CIVICS TESTING

#### ~AZ GRADUATION REQUIREMENT~

Per the American Civics Act (AZ House Bill 2064), all high school students are required to pass a civics exam as part of AZ graduation requirements. Civics testing will take place April 26-29, 2021 at MHS for all students currently enrolled in a social studies course who *have not* yet passed the exam. All students attending in-person will have their civics exam administered during their World History course. All online students will be contacted to set up an appointment to sit for their exam onsite at MHS. This test is not timed and consists of 100 multiple choice test questions.
