Herman C. Ragin Sr. was born in Houston County and attended school in Perry, graduating from the Perry Training School in 1945. He attended Johnson C. Smith University on an athletic scholarship and received his Bachelor's degree in 1949.

Because of his strong commitment to family and his community, Mr. Ragin moved back to the Perry community in 1953 to teach, coach and raise his family. He taught science and coached at the high school level from 1953 to 1964, becoming the first black head football coach and athletic director in Houston County. In 1964, Ragin became the first principal at King's Chapel Elementary and remained there until his retirement in 1980.

He taught the values he believes in- self reliance; self-improvement; devotion; drive; discipline; temperance; hard work; thrift and personal responsibility. He taught that these values are established through education – the pathway that drives his basic optimism about life – and a faith in free will and individual confidence. Mr. Ragin believes that through sweat and smarts each of us can rise above the circumstances of our birth.

He married Gloria Mason of Knoxville, Tennessee, who also taught in the Houston County School System. She retired after 31 years. Mrs. Ragin touched many students' lives with passion, love, and the belief that each child she encountered could become a productive citizen. A devoted and caring wife, mother and church member, she too is loved by many.

Mr. and Mrs. Ragin have been married for more than 57 years. They have three children - Herman Jr., Keith and Wayne - two daughters-in-law, seven grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.
