Dear Parent and Guardians,

This letter is to inform you that we were notified this afternoon of an additional positive COVID-19 case within our elementary school. The individuals who were considered close contacts are being notified and will be required to quarantine. The Pennsylvania Department of Health has been notified and we will follow any and all recommendations that they provide.

Currently, we have two positive cases at the elementary school, one confirmed positive case at the middle school, and 4 at the high school. Due to the number of positive cases, in addition to the number of quarantined students within the district, all schools will learn remotely tomorrow, Friday January 22, 2021. Students are to follow their virtual academy schedules. The buildings will be cleaned and sanitized tomorrow and all students grades Pre-K - 12 will return to their face to face schedules on Monday January 25, 2021.

COVID-19 is a disease that is capable of rapidly spreading person-to-person. People infected are capable of exposing others to COVID-19 even if their symptoms are mild, such as a cough, or even if they are asymptomatic. Additionally, exposure is possible by touching a surface or object that has the virus on it and then touching one's mouth, nose, or eyes. Symptoms of COVID-19 may include fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, repeated shaking, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, fatigue, congestion or runny nose, diarrhea, nausea/vomiting, and new loss of taste or smell. Older adults and people who have serious chronic medical conditions are at a higher risk for serious illness.

If your child develops symptoms of COVID-19 as stated above, it is extremely important that you do not send your child to school and contact your local health care provider.

The Frazier School District is concerned about the health and well-being of you, your family and the general public during this pandemic. We understand that this is a difficult time, and that some individuals may need additional support during this period.
