

DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES FOR TOBACCO PRODUCTS BAN**Students**

Students in violation of the No Smoking Policy will be penalized in accordance with the School Discipline Procedures and applicable Athletic Code Procedures. Further – students found smoking in District-owned and/or maintained buildings, facilities, and vehicles or on grounds at any time will be subject to the following:

- FIRST OFFENSE:** Suspension for three school days and reminder of State law by the principal with time and date of such suspension documented and placed in the student’s file. The offense will be reported to the police.
- SECOND OFFENSE:** Suspension for five school days and referred to Superintendent who will confer with student and parent. The offense will be reported to the police for prosecution.
- THIRD OFFENSE:** Suspension in excess of five school days and a formal hearing with School Board before the student will be allowed to return to school. The offense will be reported to the police for prosecution.
- SUBSEQUENT OFFENSES:** Suspension for 10 or more school days and/or expulsion. The offense will be reported to the police for prosecution.

The above procedures will be implemented on a school year basis.
