

Minutes of David A. Perdue Elementary School Council Meeting

Report of Principal:

- Discipline issues are beginning to pick-up. Student led toy drive was a huge success.
- Coming up - March 24, 2016 – GMAS/Fine Arts night ; Spring Fling – April 22, 2016, Field Day – May 6, 2016
- April 11, 2016 – testing begins for 3 weeks
- CCRPI – Information is slowly being released

Old Business: No old business was reported

New Business:

- Mrs. Moore presented the Legislative Updates:
 - Students must be in attendance 90% of the instructional day to be included in the teacher evaluation
 - Students growth based on the annual state assessment will be reduced from 50%-30% for teachers and from 70% to 40% for principals and assistant principals
 - Tiered evaluation system, reducing the number of observations for teachers with 3 years of experience and a rating of “proficient” or “exemplary” may be used
 - LBOE are encouraged to develop and implement multiple formative reading and math assessments for K-5

- Annual end of grade assessments in grades 3-8 in ELA/reading , math, science, and social studies in grades 5-8 shall be administered
- Beginning 2017 – 2018 tests will move as close to the end of the year or semester as possible
- May 27th - Elections (8 a.m.)
