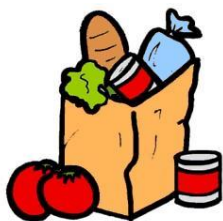


SVDP MEETING: While we will still be ministering to those in need we will not have a formal meeting until we are given the all clear by the Bishop.

COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR CATHOLIC WOMEN TO BE AWARDED

The **ASK AL KC** invite Catholic women in Alabama to apply for a \$1000 scholarship for to be used for a college or trade school of her choice. Scholarship winner will be awarded at the State Convention in April 2021. The applicant must be a *practicing Catholic and a resident of Alabama*. She may be a high school senior, someone already enrolled in college or a trade school, or a woman who would like to return to college or a trade school, or desiring to pursue a graduate degree. **This scholarship is not based solely on GPA scores.**

To apply for the scholarship please submit the following:

1. A resume.
2. A cover letter explaining why you desire the scholarship, your planned career, and why you feel you deserve the scholarship.
3. Two letters of recommendation; one of which must be from your parish priest.

The resume and cover letter should be prepared by the applicants and mailed with the two letters of recommendation, as **a complete package**, to the following:

All applications for this scholarship must be completed as stated above and ***postmarked on or before November 30th, in order to be considered!***

The applications will be reviewed by a committee of the ASK AL KC District Representatives. The winner will be contacted upon their selection in early April. It will be made payable to the college of the winner's choice. Good Luck!!
