This form serves as a "Notice of Non-Compliance" pursuant to section 120.695, Florida Statutes. Items marked as "out" violate one or more of the requirements of Chapter 64E-11, the Florida Administrative Code or Chapter 381.0072, Florida Statutes. Violations must be corrected within the time period indicated above. Continued operation of this facility without making these corrections is a violation. Failure to correct violations in the time frame specified may result in enforcement action being initiated by the Department of Health.

Violations Comments

- Violation #6. Proper eating, tasting, drinking, or tobacco use
Personal beverage (used bottle of soda) was found on food preparation table in kitchen. Personal beverages must not be consumed in food preparation area. This was moved to an appropriate location during the inspection.
CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(3). Food employees shall not eat, drink, or smoke in unauthorized locations.
- Violation #49. Non-food contact surfaces clean
Wall in back of dry goods has a porous substance that was applied to the wall which has some mold buildup. This mold buildup must be cleaned.
CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(4). Non-food contact surfaces shall be kept clean and free of an accumulation of dust, dirt, food residue, and other debris.
- Violation #56. Ventilation & lighting
There is poor lighting inside of walk in refrigerator/freezer and in dry goods. There must be at least 50 foot candles of light on surfaces where employees work with food.
CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(6)(a). Adequate exhaust ventilation hood systems in food prep and warewashing areas shall be provided and designed. 50 foot candles shall be at surfaces where employees work with food and 20 foot candles shall be at surfaces where food is provided to consumers.
