Dear Pineville family,

On December 28, 2020 our Board of Education met to discuss instructional options after the holiday break. Taking into consideration the governor's recommendations and the numbers that Bell County is experiencing, we have made the decision to continue virtual instruction for ALL STUDENTS from Monday, January 4 through Friday, January 8. Once that week is complete, our tentative plan is for students to return to their previously decided mode of instruction on Monday, January 11.

If your child was virtual before the mandatory closure, your child will continue to be virtual. If your child was on a hybrid schedule, your child will return to that hybrid schedule. If your child was in-person, he/she will return to in-person instruction on Monday, January 11. Any changes that are desired should be addressed to Mrs. Kathy Warren (K-6) or Mrs. Leslie Foster (7-12). All changes to mode of instruction should be approved through the counselors' offices.

We will continue to monitor the county numbers and our school numbers, and we are working with our local health department to make the decisions that best benefit our school, its students, and our community. Returning to in-person instruction as quickly as we can is certainly something that we have desired and worked towards, and we are excited about getting back!

It is an honor to serve our community and the families of our students, and we are extremely grateful for the support that we have received in trying to ensure that our students are safe, healthy, and educated! Our food service program will have delivered meals or pick-up meals during the week of January 4th-8th.
