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Dear Parents/Guardians:

I want to begin by thanking the students, families, and staff members of the Greenwich Township School District for all of their efforts in adapting to our new instructional platform as we continue to face many challenges brought on by the COVID-19 pandemic. At present, there is no directive from the Department of Education, Department of Health, or Governor Murphy to alter our current programming, but it is essential that the District prepares an Emergency School Closure All-Remote Learning Plan in the event that there is a mandated shutdown. This shutdown could be districtwide or for a limited portion of our population, such as the quarantine or isolation of a class, grade, or school building. **Please be advised that this Plan will only be in effect in the event that we enact a limited quarantine for a specific class, grade or school building or close schools fully and begin to operate an all-remote learning environment.**

### **Nehaunsey Middle School All-Remote Learning Plan: Grades 6-8**

All students – Maroon, Gold, and Remote – will follow 2020-2021 official bell schedule below and receive synchronous direct instruction with merged teams, five days a week, during the morning Session I. For example, if your child has Social Studies 2<sup>nd</sup> Period, they must be logged in remotely every day from 8:36 to 9:06 AM for direct instruction. Students may continue to utilize the afternoon Session II to receive more individualized help from teachers, if necessary.
