



From the nurse's office:

Dear Parent,

Please help us prevent the spread of germs in our school! Flu and other viruses are spreading. PLEASE DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL SICK! Your child must stay home for 24 hours if they have:

*** FEVER – No fever for 24 hours without Tylenol or Motrin.

THIS MEANS IF YOUR CHILD HAS A FEVER TODAY, THEY SHOULD NOT BE AT SCHOOL TOMORROW.

If you had to give them Tylenol or Motrin before coming to school, **THEY SHOULD NOT BE AT SCHOOL.**

*** VOMITING/ DIARRHEA- Must stay home 24 hours After Vomiting or Diarrhea. .

THIS MEANS IF YOUR CHILD VOMITED OR HAS DIARRHEA TODAY, THEY SHOULD NOT BE AT SCHOOL TOMORROW.

*** STREP THROAT—can return with Medical note 24 hours after starting Antibiotics and IF THERE IS NO FEVER.

IF YOU GIVE YOUR CHILD TYLENOL OR MOTRIN BEFORE COMING TO SCHOOL, THEY SHOULD NOT BE AT SCHOOL TODAY!

If the school calls for you to come pick up your sick child, please come as quickly as possible. We know some parents work out of town but students should not have sit in the nurse's office for several hours before someone is able to come pick them up from school. The longer the student is at school, the more it exposes other students to that illness.
