STS Celebrates 60 years

St. Theresa Parish has very humble beginnings. In 1947, three families donated the land on which we reside to establish a Catholic Mission Church which became an extended part of the Cathedral of St. Andrew. The first church, a simple small white building, was completed in 1951, and later became the school cafeteria until 1973 when the current church was built. St. Theresa became a developed parish in 1954, and the school was established in 1959. Classes were held in the parish hall until 1961 when a building of four classrooms was erected. A second such unit was added in 1963. The school structure was expanded in the 1980s to add Prekindergarten, Kindergarten, and special activity classes, as well as to reduce class sizes. This project was completed over time utilizing the time and talents of parents and parishioners. St. Theresa Catholic School has always had dedicated people attending to its needs and wants. We consider our community to be a jewel in the Southwest Little Rock neighborhood. This year, Saint Theresa celebrates 60 years of educating our community.
