Positions on the Ballot

- School Board Trustee, (4 year term) General Election – 3 Positions

Qualifications of Board Candidates

A qualified candidate shall be defined as a person who is:

- a registered voter in the May Independent School District.
- a resident in the May Independent School District for six (6) months and a resident of the State of Texas for twelve (12) months prior to the filing deadline for election.
- 18 years of age (or older) on the first day of the term to be filled at the election.
- a person who meets all other requirements as provided by law stated in Texas Election Laws: Election Code: Subchapter A: Eligibility Requirements for Public Office: Section 141.001.

Election Information

Applications for a place on the ballot can be obtained at the May ISD Administration Building, 3400 County Road 411 E, May, Texas 76857. Applications are available for pick up during normal business hours, 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM. Note: during the month of July office hours are Monday through Thursday 8:00 AM – 1:00 PM.

Deadline to Post Notice of Candidate Filing Deadline (Local Political Subdivisions Only)	Thursday, June 18, 2020 for local political subdivisions that have a first day to file for their candidates
First Day to File for a Place on the General Election Ballot (Local Political Subdivisions Only)	Saturday, July 18, 2020
Last Day to File for a Place on the General Election Ballot (Local Political Subdivisions Only)	Monday, August 17, 2020 at 5:00 PM
Last Day to File a Declaration of Write-in Candidacy (Local Political Subdivisions Only)	Friday, August 21, 2020
Deadline to hold drawing to determine order of candidate’s names on the ballot. Notice of the date, hour, and place of the ballot must be posted continuously for 72 hours immediately preceding	Monday, August 24, 2020

First Day of Early Voting by Personal Appearance	Monday, October 19, 2020
Deadline to deliver notice of the election to the county election officer	Friday, September 4, 2020
Timeframe in which to publish notice of the election	October 5-25, 2020
Deadline to post notice of election on bulletin board used for posting board meeting notices	Tuesday, October 13, 2020
Last Day to Apply for Ballot by Mail (Received, not Postmarked)	Friday, October 23, 2020
Last Day of Early Voting by Personal Appearance	Friday, October 30, 2020
