- Daniel Pratt Elementary is not responsible for any valuables students leave unsecured in lockers.



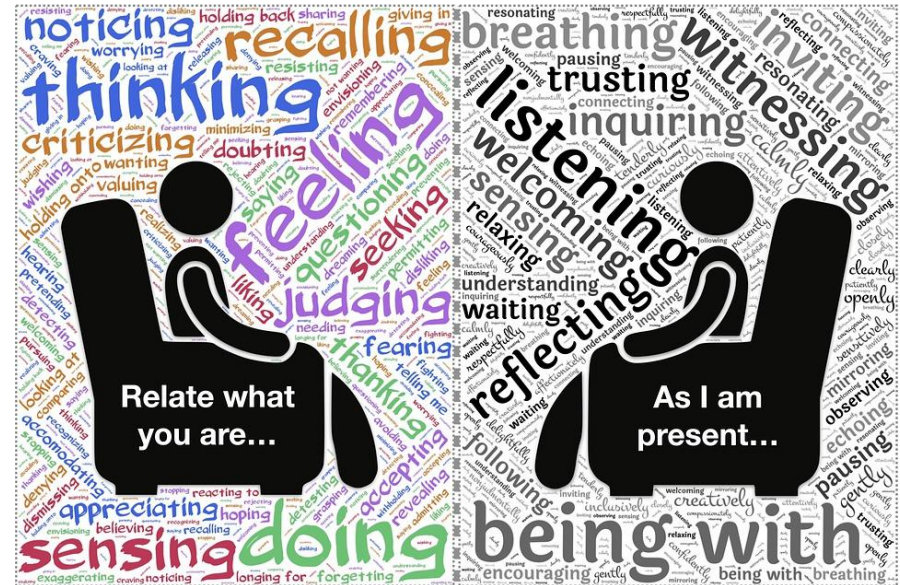
Bullying

Attendance/ Absences
