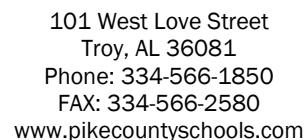

- Enroll in a Pike County School
- Apply during the 10th grade year
- ACT Score (with a 20 in English)
- GPA 3.0 minimum
- Good attendance
- Good discipline/Conduct
- Overall good standing with their school
- Academy application completed
- Transcript
- Recommendation letter from administrator (School/District)
- Recommendation form from teachers (3)
- Essay – 125-200 words explaining why you would be an excellent candidate for one of our academies
- Complete Troy University admission process

- Honors English 9, Honors English 10
- Physical Science, Honors Biology
- World History, U. S. History 10
- Foreign Language (Minimum 1 credit)
