The time for celebration is after the ceremony, when students can enjoy the company of their families and friends. Any individuals involved with disrupting the ceremony will be escorted from the ceremony.

Based on governmental orders due to COVID-19, we will allow each graduate four tickets for their respective graduation ceremony. Each high school will issue tickets along with other important information about the ceremonies in a drive-thru method on June 15. Each school will provide additional school-specific information to their graduates soon. We look forward to joining with you as we congratulate each of our graduates. This occasion is a joyous one, and we want everyone to participate in this celebration in a positive way.
