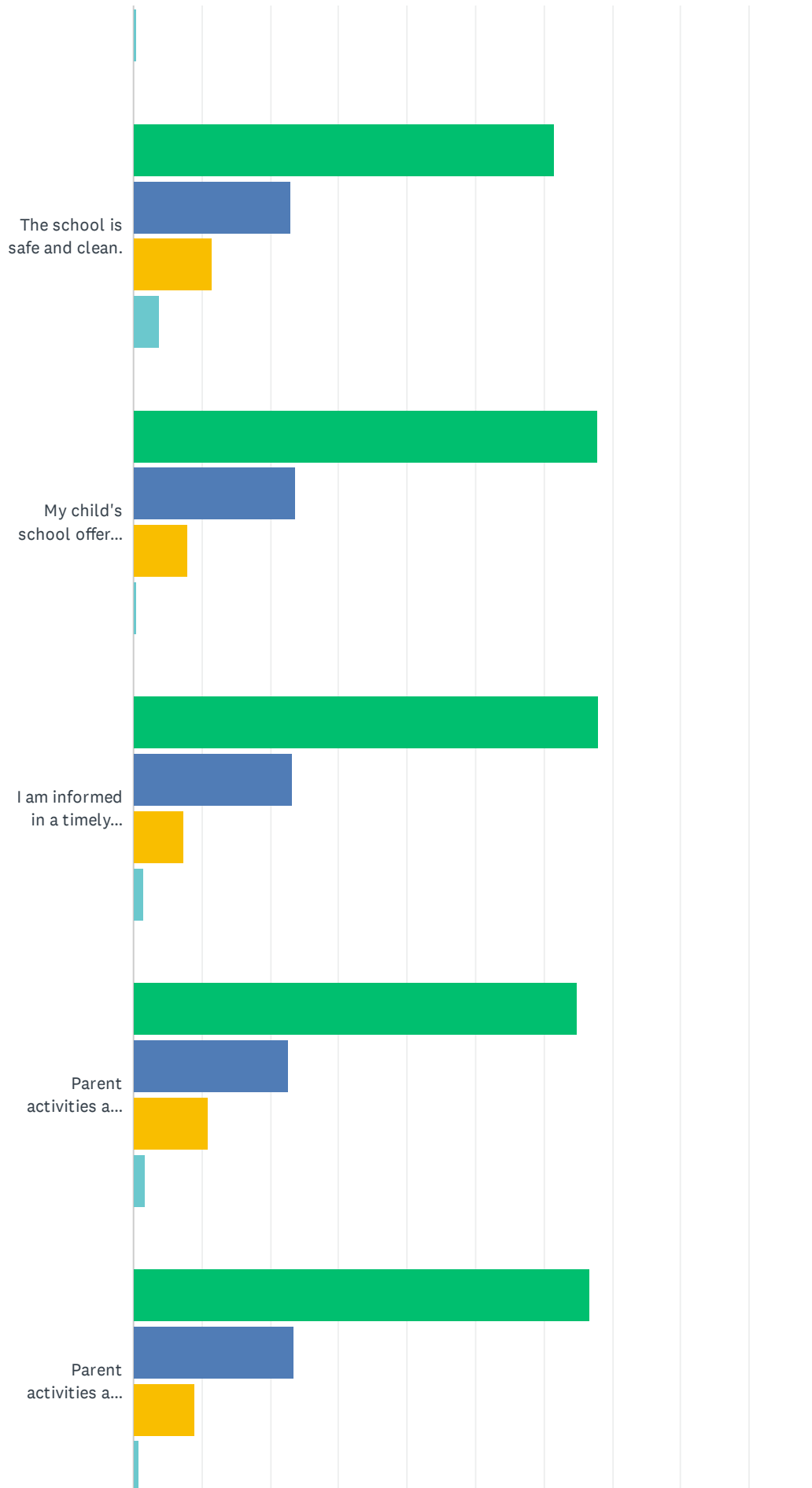

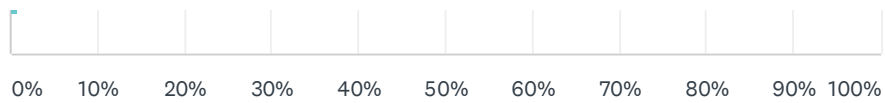

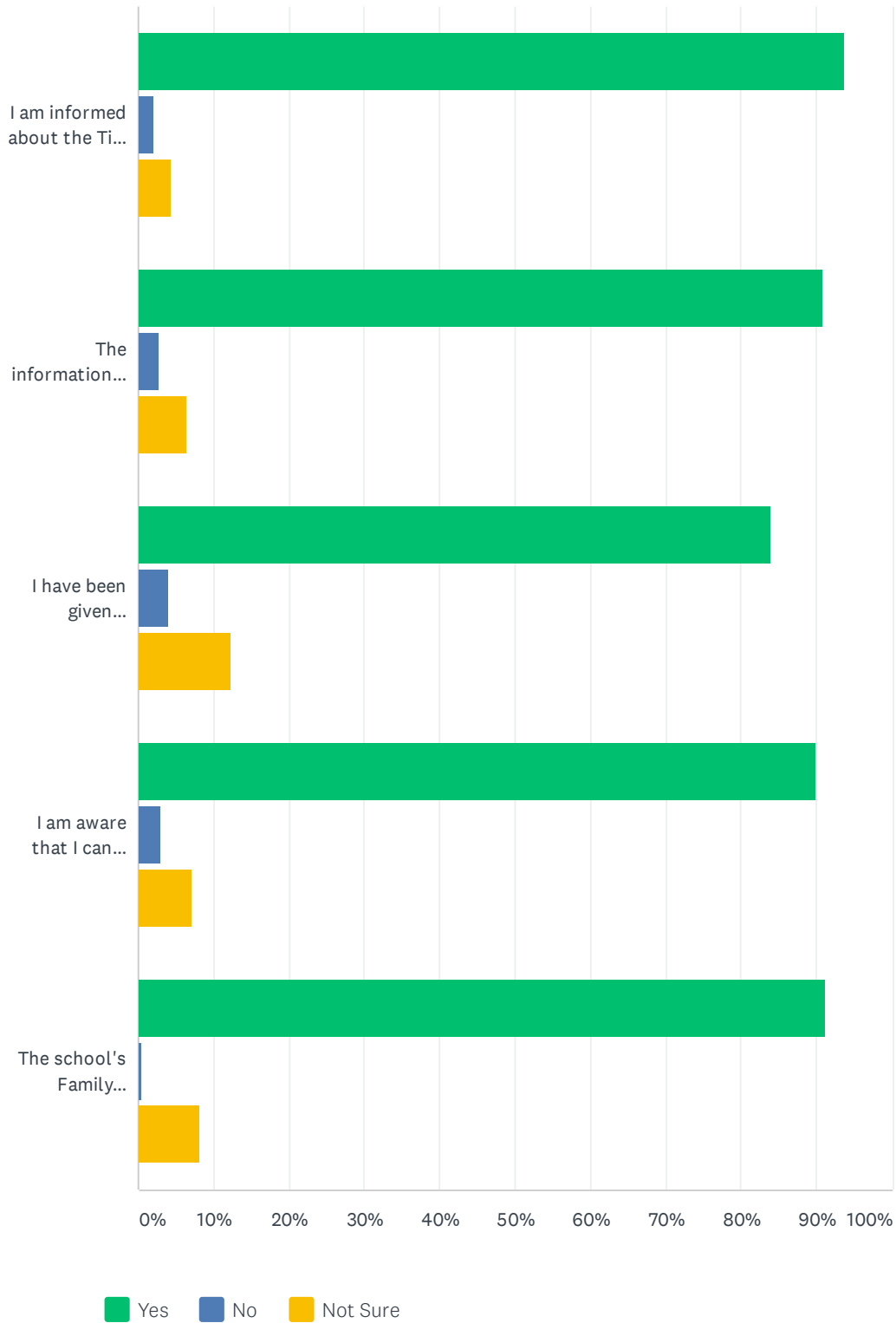

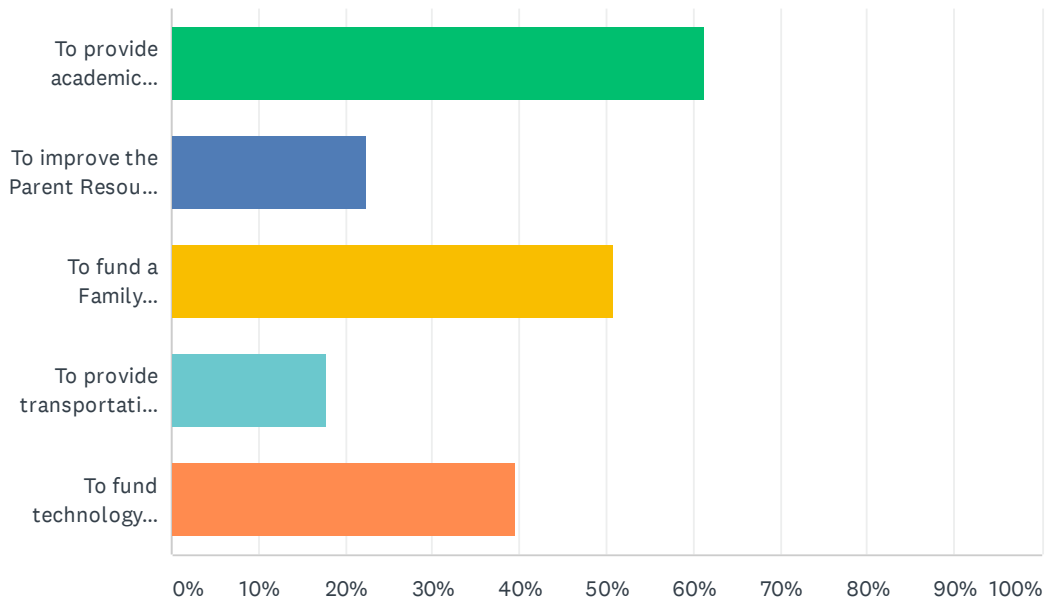

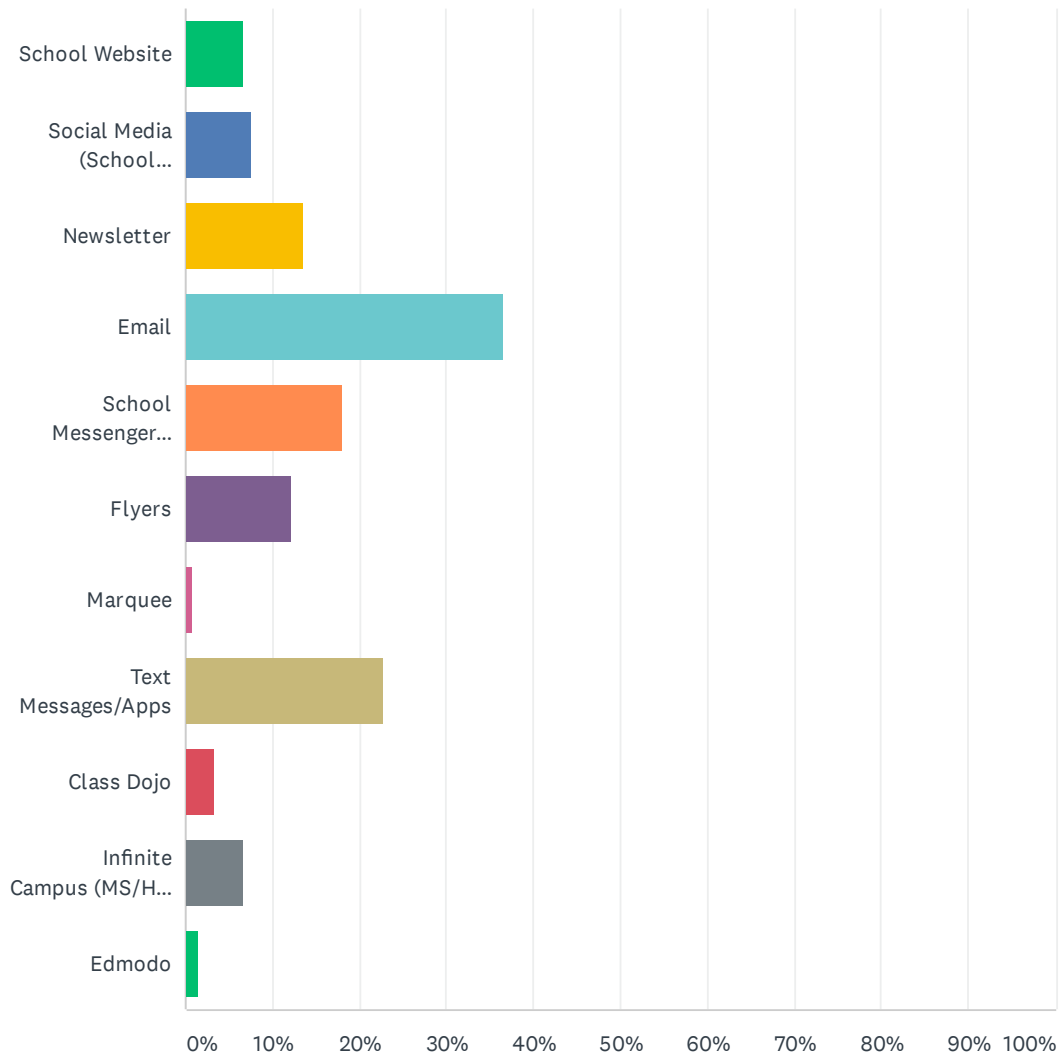

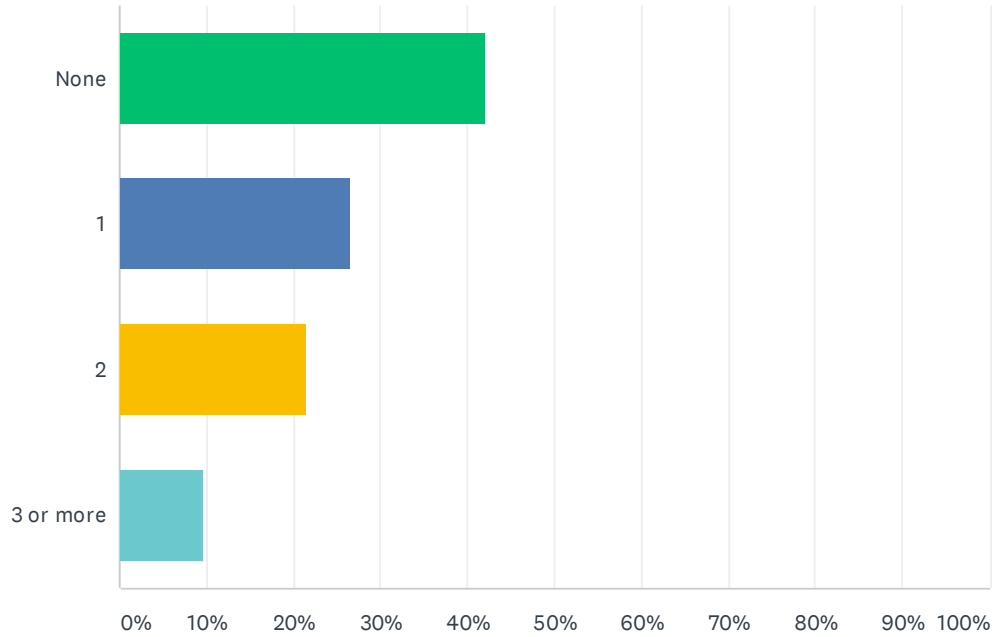

### Q8 How many academic parent events have you attended this year?

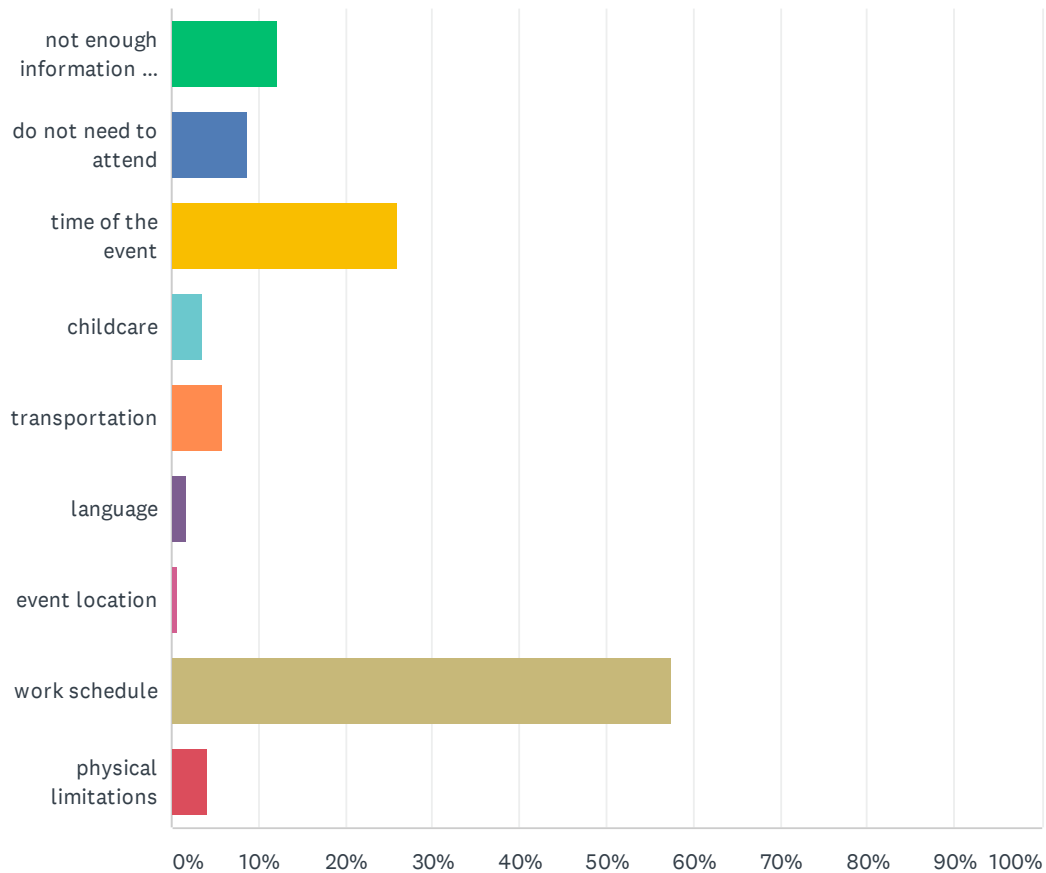

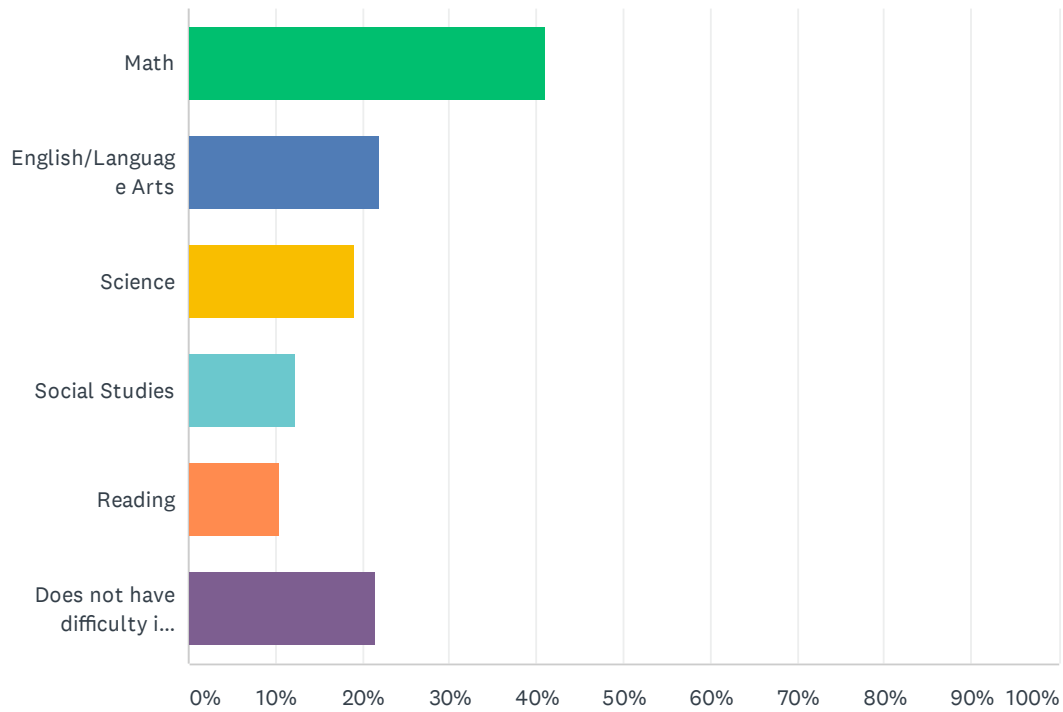

### Q10 Choose the subject area that you feel your student has the most difficulty mastering content.

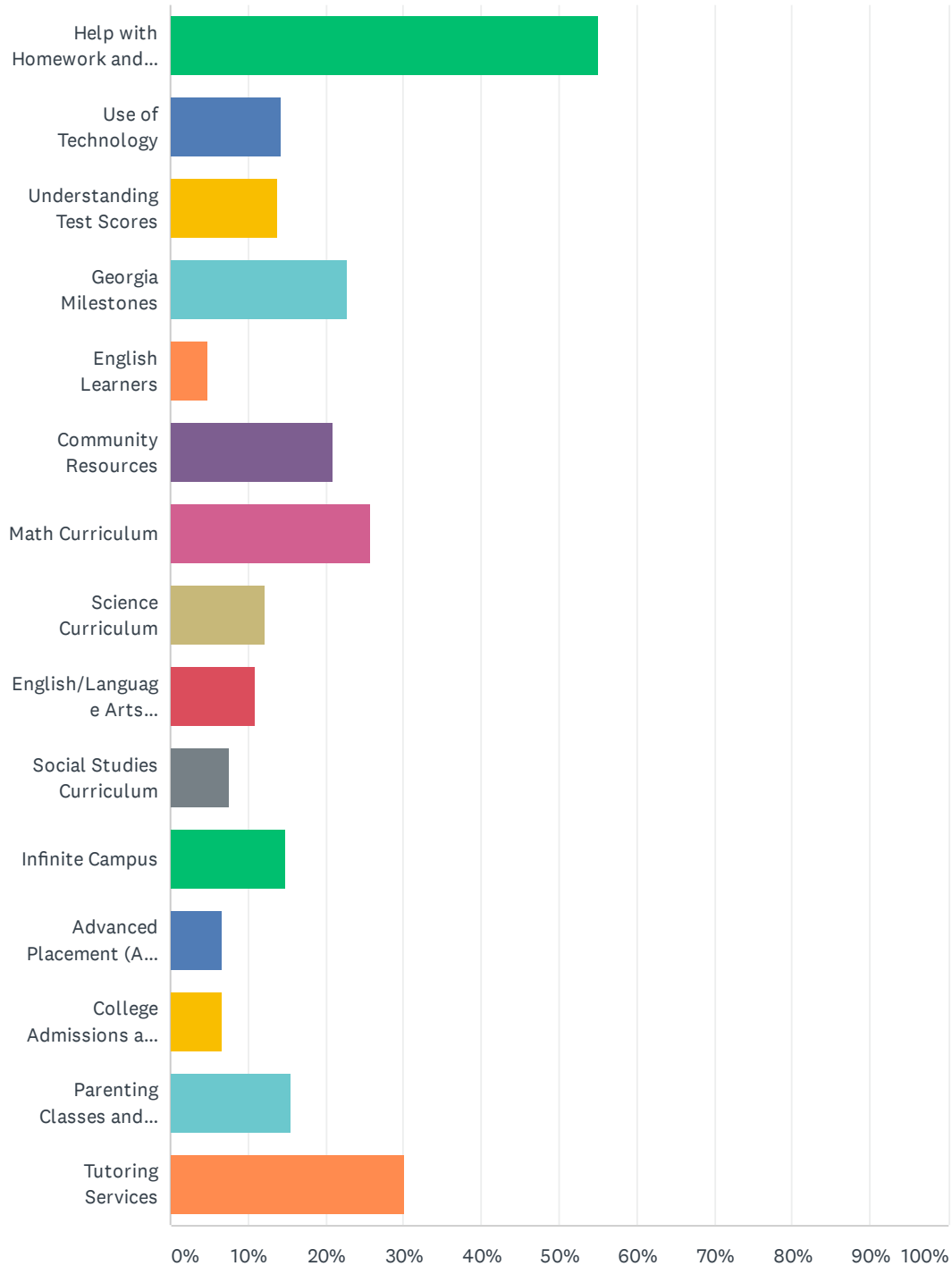
