A regular meeting of the Board of Education was held on Monday, October 07, 2019, at Tyrrell Middle School. Principals gave two-minutes updates on each school. Elementary School Principals reported on their Fall Festivals, I-Ready Testing the Governor Summer Reading Challenge and other events that have been happening in their buildings.

Mr. Norcross reported on the I-Ready testing at Tyrrell, the governor's reading challenge and the kick-off of One School One book, where they had an author visit who will be naming a character "Tyrrell" in her next book.

Mr. Drewry spoke of how they are following through with the Vision of the graduate at Wolcott High School, everyone is adjusting well to the new Block Scheduling and they are preparing for their NEASC visit in November. He also thanked two students for going above and beyond for their community service, they are knitting hats to donate to the homeless. **Discussion on Kindergarten Testing:**

Mrs. Cordone gave a presentation on changes of the Kindergarten curriculum. She handed out articles and referenced key points from them in regards to Kindergarten students needing more active play and less testing. Mrs. Cordone provided articles of research that have shown that testing at a young age could be harmful, cause stress and anxiety and stated that Kindergarten students are not ready to have such test as I-Ready given to them. She gave examples from research that was done in Finland and statements that reflected why Finland is one of the top rated countries in education. The Board agreed to create a committee of the Board of Education members, administrators, and teachers.
