Description	<p>Academic discourse helps students develop deep understanding and flexible thinking. In MATH TALK MOVES PART 1, teachers learned Talk Moves to help students clarify their thinking, listen with purpose, deepen their reasoning, and engage with the reasoning of others.</p> <p>In this course, the focus is on classroom norms that support respectful discourse and equitable participation. Teachers will examine students’ rights and responsibilities and the ground rules that must be in place to support effective classroom talk. While the video examples are from math classes, the need to establish norms applies to any academic discourse.
