



# Arthur I. Boreman Safe Re-Entry



Parents,

Safety is paramount at A.I.B.! While we would love to return to how things once were, our current reality has changed. We are putting procedures in place to combat spread of the virus to the best of our ability. Here are some of the highlights as to how we are working to make this as safe a return as possible.

## Parent Drop Off

- Parent drop will begin at 7:30. Please do not drop your students off before 7:30. Students dropped off will go straight to homeroom. Teacher is on duty to ensure student safety. Homeroom Teachers will be ready in their rooms to receive students.

## Bus Drop Off

- Students riding a bus will be required to wear a mask. Students will be expected to wear the mask until they have arrived in their homerooms.
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- Same as it always has been. Students will go directly to homeroom. Homeroom Teachers will be ready in their rooms to receive students.

## Parent Pick Up

- Similar to what has been done in the past. Parents or guardians picking up students after school will be required to wear a mask. Parents will sign out their student outside the front doors. Your child will be brought out to you. Please be mindful of others and socially distance yourselves to avoid congestion at the front of the school.

## Masks/General Cleaning

- Staff will wear face coverings in hallways and will be encouraged to wear face coverings in class as comfortable. All staff remain socially distant to the best of their ability.
- Students 3<sup>rd</sup> grade and up will wear face coverings in the hallways.
- Social Distancing will be enforced in lines and in groups.
- Gatherings will be very limited to core groups of students.
- Handwashing/hand sanitizing will be frequent.
- Items that are/could be used by multiple groups will be sanitized between uses.

### Wellness Checks

All students will be asked the WV Re-Entry Tool Kit Daily Screening  
All staff will be screened each day prior to starting school.

### Meals

- Students' grades 1 -5 will eat in their classrooms.
- Students will have the opportunity to eat on tables outdoors as much as possible.
- PreK and Kindergarten students will eat in the cafeteria socially distanced

### Nurse's Office

- Boreman will have two Nurse's Offices, one for students who might display symptoms and the other for typical first aid or non-symptomatic students.

### Recess

- Students will have recess outdoors as long as it is not raining and 40 degrees or above. Please plan accordingly.

### Late Bus

- Students will be grouped together by bus. Each bus will be separated so they are social distancing and not all sitting together in the cafeteria. Students will be required to wear a mask at late bus.

### Specialists

- Specialist teachers of Music/Art/STEAM/Library will conduct class in the student's homeroom.
- Gym classes will take place outdoors as often as possible, if in the gym spacing will be enforced.

### Visiting the School

- If you are bringing a child late to school or picking them up early we are asking that you remain outside and we will bring the sign in or out sheet to you. If you are bringing something to school to give to your child, such as a lunch, we ask that you leave it outside and a staff member will come out to get the item. Our goal is to reduce visitors in the building as much as possible.
