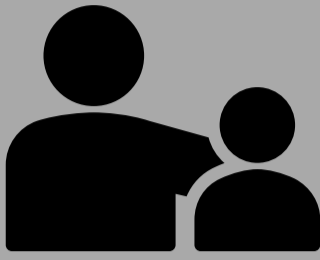

Sign up as an observer to view your student's Canvas page

Teachers at Seaside Middle School and High School use Canvas for all assignments, announcements, and grading. Canvas is the best way for families and students to see coursework, graded assignments and missing assignments.



Observers in Canvas

Parents and guardians can sign up for a Canvas account as an observer. Observers can link their Canvas account to their student's to see assignments, due dates, announcements, and other course content.

As an observer you can view course content that has been published, but cannot participate in the course. To link to a student's Canvas page you must have a Student Pairing Code.



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What are pairing codes?

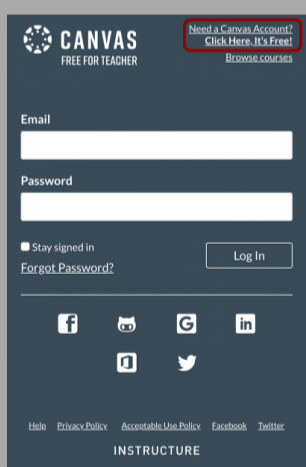
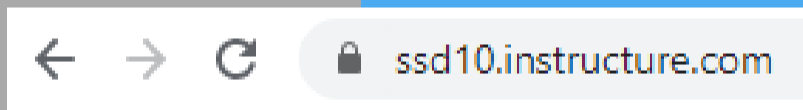
Pairing codes are six-digit codes that are used to link students to observers in Canvas. Pairing codes are sent out by teachers and expire after seven days if unused.

You will need a separate pairing code for each student that you are linking to your account. To add additional students once your account is created click on **Account** in the sidebar, then select **Observing** and then enter the **Student Pairing Code**.

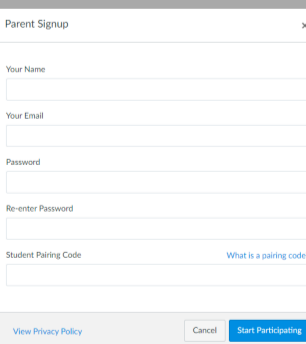


How do I create a Canvas account?

1. In a browser window, enter your school's Canvas URL:

2. Click on: **Need a Canvas Account? Click Here, It's Free!** In the top right corner.



3. Enter your name and email address, create a password for your account, and enter your Student Pairing Code to link your account to your student's account.
