RECEIPT OF CONSEQUENCES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE WITH SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

State law requires minor children to be enrolled in and attend school. Pursuant to O.C.G.A. 20-2-690.1, a parent/guardian may be held responsible for the child's failure to report to school. A fine of up to \$100 per day may be assessed and imprisonment for up to 30 days may be imposed.

Other possible consequences:

- 1. After school detention
- 2. In-school suspension
- 3. Loss of parking permit
- 4. Possible loss of course credit
- 5. Possible referral to juvenile court as a truant student in accordance with O.C.G.A. 15-11-6
- 6. Possible denial or suspension of a driver's license in accordance with O.C.G.A. 40-5-2
