 - Each grade level had a half day planning during the month of January to create common formative assessments to target ELA for the 3rd 9 weeks
 - i. What are CFAs?—Short assessments created to quickly assess each student's understanding of a concept of an essential standard to help create differentiated instruction.
 - In February teams have brought their specific data for five individual students in their classroom from the MAPs, GKIDS2.0, running records, anecdotal notes, and CFAs to create academic opportunity lessons that were specifically targeted for each student.
 - In February teams met with our school level MAPs teacher leader with the district representative from Assessment and Accountability to review the data reports for MAPs growth and fluency winter administrations.
- 6. Current Pilot Programs-We are currently working with Mentoring Minds. In piloting supplemental ELA and Math remediation and enrichment activities for academic opportunity time, we are looking to complement our current instructional programs.
