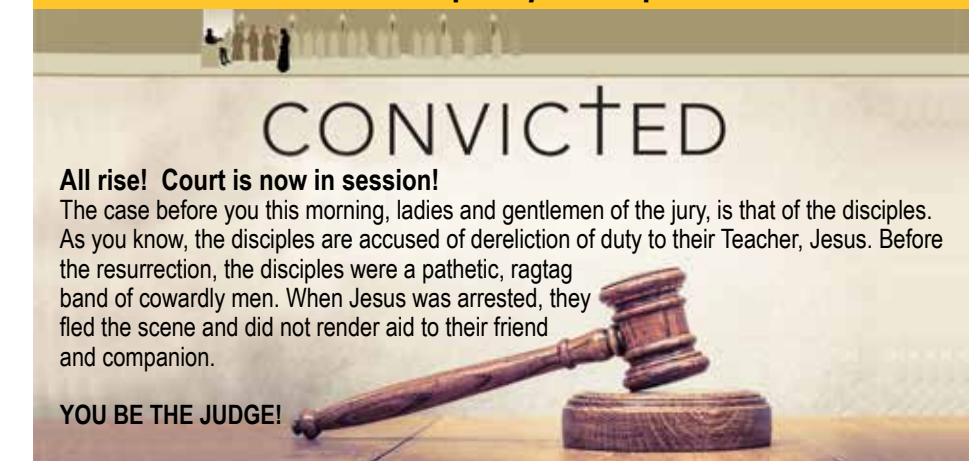

- Do I believe I am a sinner and am I sorry for my sins?
- Do I earnestly intend with the help of God to amend my sinful life?
- Do I believe Christ's true body and blood to be present in the Lord's Supper for the forgiveness of sins?

If you are physically unable to come forward for Communion: Please let an usher know and the pastor will come to you and give you Communion.

Gluten Free - Ask an usher for a GLUTEN FREE PLEASE card when you attend communion. These are an easy and silent way to ask for a gluten free communion wafer.

For the past twenty nine years, Divine Redeemer's Christian Scholarship Foundation has been proud to award Christian scholarships to high school seniors that will graduate from a Waukesha County high school. We are pleased to announce that we will award five scholarships this year. A \$2,500 scholarship will be awarded to a deserving male applicant and one to a female applicant.

The Garrett Becker Scholarship will be given to an applicant who has overcome a significant obstacle in their life or if the applicant intends to work in the health care field. The Jean Pordon Memorial Scholarship for \$7,000 will be awarded to the candidate who will enter the music or education field.
