Northside Middle Top 5 in Nation for FFA Model of Excellence



HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – Northside Middle School’s FFA chapter was named in the top five in the nation for the 2019 National FFA Middle School Model of Excellence award. This is the highest honor that the National FFA organization bestows upon a middle school chapter.

The National FFA Middle School Model of Excellence award recognizes outstanding chapters that actively implement the FFA mission and strategies. Middle school chapters had to earn a high three-star rating during judging to be considered for eligibility. Northside Middle’s students are one of only five teams that will compete at the 92nd National FFA Convention and Expo, and all five finalists are from the state of Georgia. For the competition, the students gave a presentation and an interview.

Schools improve their chapter operations using the National Quality FFA Chapter Standards and a Program of Activities that emphasizes growing leaders, building communities and strengthening agriculture. Chapters are rewarded for providing educational experiences for the entire membership.

The National FFA Organization provides leadership, personal growth and career success training through agricultural education to 669,989 student members who belong to one of 8,630 local FFA chapters throughout the U.S., Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands. Currently, 459,514 alumni members in 2,236 alumni chapters throughout the U.S. also support the organization.
