

PCBOE Will Destroy Special Education Records

The Perry County Board of Education Special Education Department will be destroying records of students who were born between the years of 1950-1990 and were referred/evaluated and/or identified as an individual with special needs. The records are being destroyed because they have been maintained the maximum amount of years as prescribed by Federal law {290-8-9.08(2)}. The records will be destroyed September 30, 2019. Identification and signed release of information will be required prior to the release of any Special Education records.
