Kindergarten Registration: Kindergarten Registration for the 2021-2022 school year has begun. All registration will be completed online at pinelevelelem.com. Pre-K students DO NOT register online; however, you do need to reverify by bringing 2 proofs of residence. Please remind all of your friends and family who have upcoming PLES Kindergarteners to go to our website and register.
