## Service Excellence Scholarship Guidelines

## **Application & Approval Process**

Upon approval of the Scholarship Committee, the Junior Auxiliary of Greenville shall award one \$500 scholarship to a deserving student. The scholarship purpose is to provide financial assistance to a student pursuing a higher education.

This scholarship was established in 2012 as a way for the Junior Auxiliary of Greenville to recognize a youth that has been an outstanding volunteer.

Resumes may be submitted by graduating seniors that have been accepted to an accredited college/university. This scholarship is based solely on community service efforts. The \$500 scholarship will be awarded in April and presented at Senior Awards Day. Entries must be post marked no later than March 1st. Letters will be sent to area schools in January to inform counselors and prospective applicants of the scholarship.

## Eligibility

- Must be a graduating senior from a local area high school. This includes private, parochial, and public schools in Washington County. The Western line school district as well as Greenville Public schools will be included.
- 2. Must be accepted to an accredited college or university.
- 3. Must be involved in community service, preferably with children.

## General Information

- 1. Scholarship is awarded on a yearly basis.
- 2. Service Excellence scholarship will be a line item in the chapter annual budget.
- 3. Completed resumes are to be typed hand-written resumes will not be considered.
- Resumes are only to include community service.
- 5. One letter of recommendation and an official high school transcript should be included with resume.
- Completed resumes and attachments are to be postmarked by March 1st.
- 7. Scholarship Committee shall consist of chairman and three members at large, elected at November chapter meeting. Committee members shall not have a child eligible for scholarship.
- 8. Resumes are kept confidential.
- Scholarship recipient will be announced at the April Chapter meeting.
- 10. Scholarship recipient will be notified by mail.
- 11. Scholarship award will be presented to recipient during high school senior awards day. The JA president or Scholarship chairman shall coordinate this with the appropriate school.
