Dr. April Greene addressed the parent concerns of the back car ramp awning. The insurance was settled and the new awning should be installed January.

Another school concern is the parking situation and constant parking on the front area of the school. This is killing the grass and just does not make our school look good. We have constant access from Lake Joy Rd, and parents are just pulling off of the road onto the grass. Some suggestions were to plant more crape myrtles to encourage people to only enter the area from one location. We also would like to send another letter to explain why this is a safety issue.
