Warhawk Family:

Thank you for your continued support of our student athletes during these unprecedented times. I would like to give some clarification on some changes and restrictions for our fall sports. We ask that you adhere to these guidelines, and understand the guidelines are in place to better protect our athletes, coaches, and spectators.

Track: The Warhawks track team will be away for most of our meets. Tickets will be sold at the gate for \$5.00. There will be limited seating. Social distancing should be exercised when practically possible. Masks and/or face coverings will be encouraged, but not required. No spectators will be allowed in and or around the track area.

Soccer: The Warhawks will begin season play at home on February 17th, 2021. The COVID-19 stadium capacity will be 35% of the normal capacity. Due to limited seating and ticket availability, all tickets will be purchased in advance. Season (\$56.00) tickets can be purchased at the PHS gate on February 4th and February 17th and 18th at Freedom Field gate (cash or check only, made out to VHS Soccer). General admission tickets (\$8.00 for double header and \$5.00 for single game and JV games) will be available for purchase on GoFan until tickets are sold out. Tickets must be purchased on line through GoFan application. Information will be sent out weekly. Spectators should not rely on ticket availability on game days. Sideline access for spectators and athletes at all contests will be limited to **ESSENTIAL** players and personnel. Social distancing should be exercised when practically possible. Masks and/or face coverings will be encouraged, but not required.

Baseball: Tickets (\$5.00/\$8.00 doubleheader) are sold on GoFan. COVID-19 seating capacity is at 50% of full capacity, and spectators should expect ticket sellouts due to capacity at most games. Spectators should bring chairs and sit on marked areas near the baseball field. Social distancing should be exercised when practically possible. Masks and/or face coverings will be encouraged, but not required. Dugout access for spectators and athletes at all contests will be limited to **ESSENTIAL** players and personnel.

Tennis: The Warhawks will host their first meet on February 3rd, 2021. The Tennis Complex is operated by the City of Warner Robins. Veterans High School will not charge an entry fee. The address for the Tennis Complex is 110 Bear Country Boulevard in Warner Robins. Social distancing should be exercised when possible. Masks and/or face coverings will be encouraged, but not required.

Golf: There will be no entry fee for golf matches. Spectators are allowed to follow golfers throughout the course on the cart path, no contact is allowed with the players. Social distancing should be exercised when practically possible. Masks and/or face coverings will be required when social distancing is not possible.

Essential players and personnel are defined as:

1. Students participating in the respective scheduled contest
2. Coaches, Faculty, and Staff assigned to contest
3. Athletic Trainer/Doctors
4. Security
5. Custodial staff
6. Scorer's table personnel
