



COVID-19 General Notification Letter in Educational Setting

October 9, 2020

Dear Parents and Guardians,

The Huron County Health Department has notified us on October 8th of a probable or confirmed COVID-19 case amongst an a.m. student, teacher, staff member, coach, volunteer, or any other person who was present on Huron Area Technical Center or at a school function under circumstances that may result in the transmission or contraction of COVID-19 during their infectious period.

In communication with the Health Department, we feel there were no other exposures to other students.

- Cleaning and disinfecting of the exposed location have been completed.
- If your child was in close contact with a confirmed individual, **you will be contacted by the Huron County Health Department. Please take their call and follow the recommendations they provide.**
- All confirmed cases should be isolated and close contacts quarantined for 14 days from last exposure in order to prevent illness in new persons. “Close contact” means being a household member, intimate contact, or caregiver of a confirmed or suspected COVID-19 case; within 6 feet of the confirmed or suspected COVID-19 case for more than 15 minutes, even if wearing a non-medical face covering; or having unprotected contact with the infected person’s body fluids and/or secretions, for example, being coughed or sneezed on.
- Please note that all information, including the name(s) of ill persons, is confidential in order to protect patient privacy.
- In accordance with MDHHS Emergency Order Under MCL 333.2253 – Reporting of Confirmed and Probable Cases of COVID-19 at Schools, This notice has been posted within 24 hours to the district website on October 9, 2020 at 10:00 a.m.
