





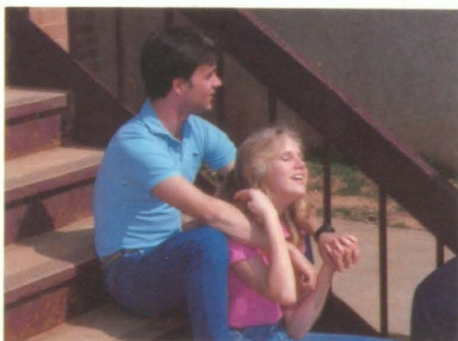

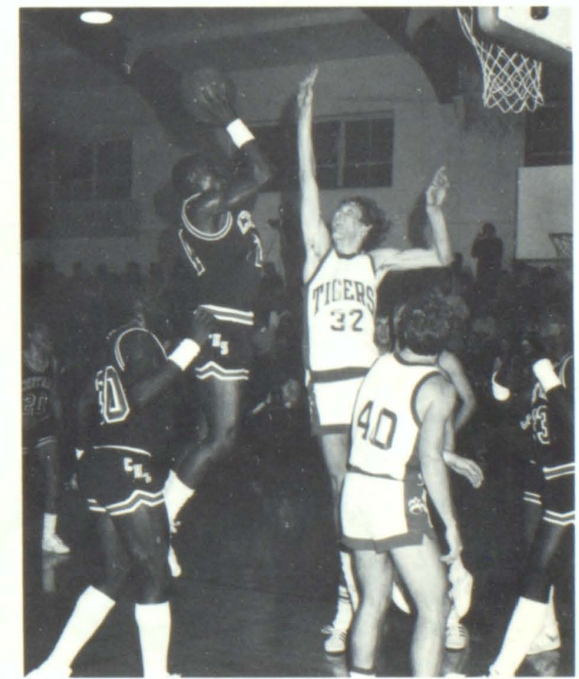

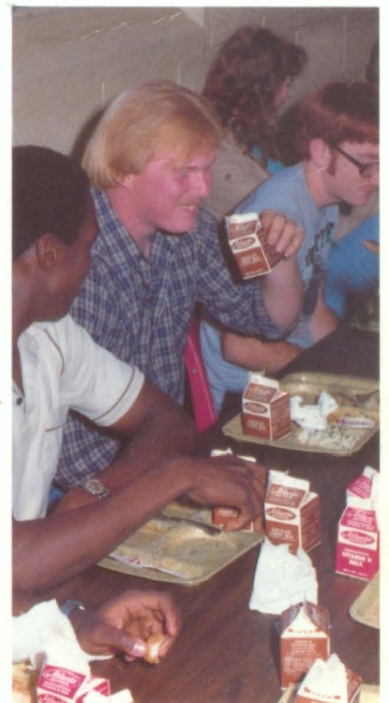
# SPIRIT

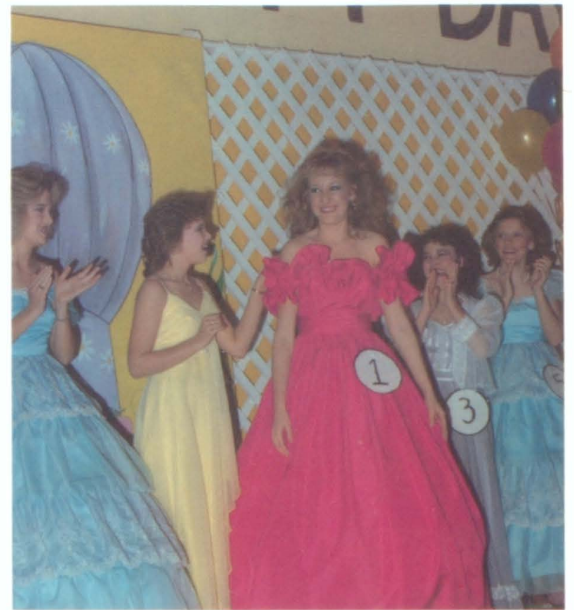

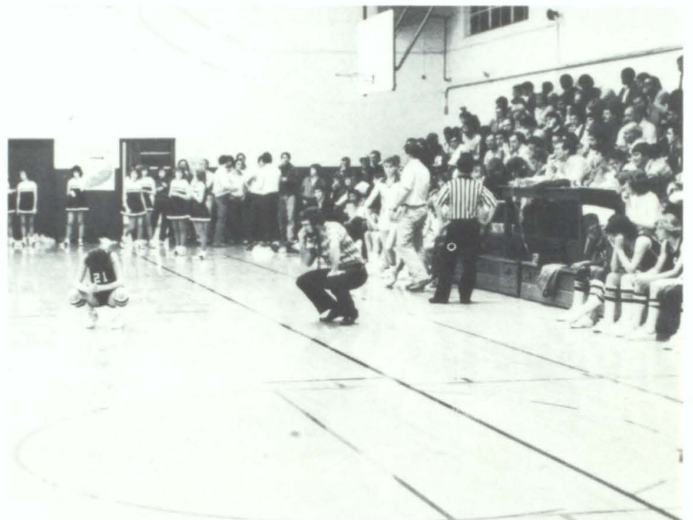


## LAUGHTER

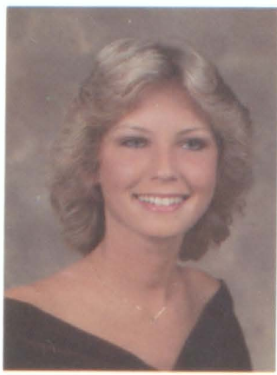
# Seniors Appointed as County Officials

They were able to observe firsthand the duties of their specific offices while representing the Class of 1983 in an outstanding manner.

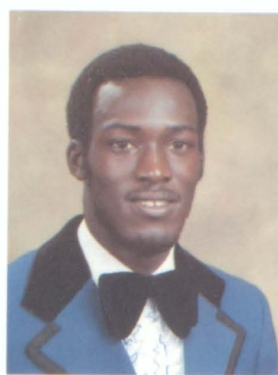

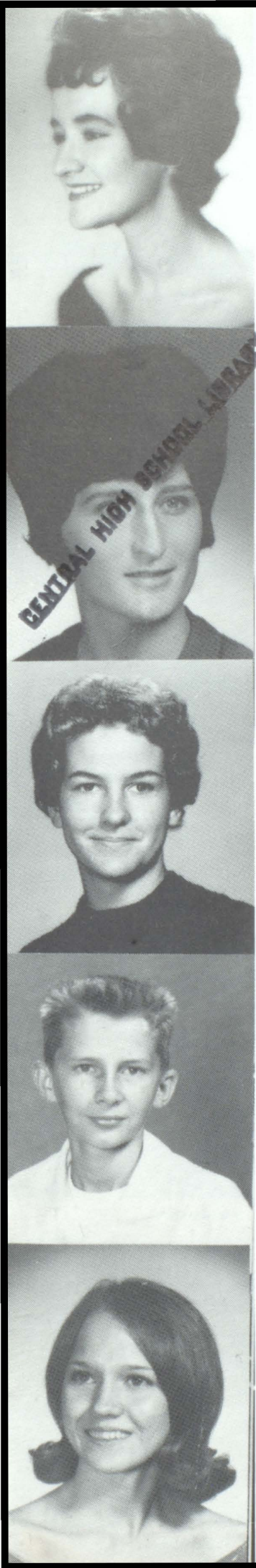


# TEACHERS . . .
