Never underestimate the importance of a strong foundation. At Guardian Catholic School, we know how critical learning is during a child's early years. Children from lower income families typically enter school with below average language skills. Language skills deficits increase the odds of dropping out of school in the future. The COVID-19 pandemic has magnified the educational disparities of all our children; perhaps the hardest hit are low income pre-school age children.

Recognizing this reality, Guardian Catholic keeps early learning as a priority and has emerged over the years as a model early learning program in Northeast Florida.

For 18 years, Sister Darlene Siebeneck led Guardian Catholic's Early Learning Program. She teamed with teachers and staff to lay the foundation of a high quality program recognized for its successful learning outcomes. Her many local, state and national awards attest
