Reading

We will be reviewing kindergarten skills this week, reading lots of books together, learning rules and procedures, and getting to know each other.

Homework this week is to read each night, practice identifying letters and sounds, and practice kindergarten high frequency words.

Next week we will begin Unit 1 in Reading. We will take a PRACTICE reading test on 9/17 to get students used to the routine. **The first graded Reading Test will be on Friday, September 25.**

High Frequency Words

The Kindergarten High Frequency Words are in your child's binder on a pink sheet. If your child cannot read all of the Kindergarten words, please help him or her practice at home. If your child knows all of the Kindergarten words, have him or her practice the Unit 1 Words.

Spelling

Spelling will begin next week. The first week's test will be for PRACTICE on 9/17. The first set of spelling words are "Week 1 – Sam, Come Back!" on a yellow sheet in your child's binder. **The first graded Spelling Test will be on Thursday, September 24.**

Math

We will be reviewing numbers and making graphs in math this week. There is a Hundred Chart in your child's binder on a pink sheet. Please have your child practice counting to 100 (or counting to 20 if he/she is not ready to count to 100). We will not have a math test until October.

Social Studies/Science

Some weeks we will have a science unit of study, and some weeks it will be social studies. This week we will be talking about Rules & Responsibilities in Social Studies.
