- i. Marisa Parrish asked "When can students return to face to face learning if they are currently virtual?"
 - 1. Students must decide November 12-19 what type of learning they will do second semester.
 - 2. Distance learners are now able to participate in scheduled tutoring sessions on campus with parent permission.
 - ii. The Odysseyware platform was explained for members not familiar with it as well as some struggles students have had using it.
 - iii. Dr. Rizer anticipates a second round of an increased number of students to be quarantined 1-2 weeks after returning from Thanksgiving Break due to students traveling and being around positive Covid-19 cases without knowing. His concern is due to the number of quarantined students 1-2 weeks after the return from Fall Break.
 - iv. Dr. Rizer mentioned the increase in the student drop out rate and his concern that students who remain distance learners that are being allowed to work during the day will decide to get their GED instead of returning to high school. This has become a trend with virtual students.
