B and D are incorrect because "Could of", "Should of", and "Would of" are ALWAYS wrong.

20. G

F and J are both a comma splice. You need a period after B.C.

Most concise answer. The shorter more concise answer is better.

J and G do not focus on the harmonica. H talks more about parts of the harmonica.

Notice the word LEAST

24. F

G is incorrect because you must have a sentence before and after a semicolon. H is incorrect because you must have a comma.

B poorly written. C He has already said he was interested in the harmonica. D the Franklin stove and the lighting rod have nothing to do with this article.

There will be questions about "Who" and "Whom"

"Who" does the verb; "Whom" receives the verb. "Who" pitches; "Whom" catches.
