## **Academic Rigor Requirements for the HOPE Scholarship**

For the High School Graduating Class of 2017 and beyond, a student meeting the requirements to be a HOPE Scholar at the time of high school graduation must earn a minimum of **four** full credits from the academic rigor course categories listed below prior to graduating from high school.

Parents and students are encouraged each semester to check his/her HOPE Scholarship eligibility and to check for the latest HOPE Scholarship updates at <a href="https://www.gafutures.org">www.gafutures.org</a>.

HOPE Scholarship will pay a percentage of tuition to students seeking an associate or bachelor degree at an eligible four year, two year, or technical college, if a student meets all eligibility requirements. For students seeking a diploma or a certificate from a technical college, tuition may be paid through the HOPE Grant which does not have a GPA or rigor requirement. Credits received for academic rigor courses must be selected from the categories below:

- 1. Advanced math, such as advanced algebra and trigonometry, Algebra II taken at the high school, or an equivalent or higher course taken for degree level credit at an eligible postsecondary institution;
- 2. Advanced science, such as chemistry, physics, Biology II, taken at the high school, or an equivalent or higher course taken for degree level credit at an eligible postsecondary institution;
- 3. Foreign language courses (II level and beyond) taken at the high school, or taken for degree level credit at an eligible postsecondary institution; or
- 4. Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate or Dual Credit Enrollment courses in core subjects.
