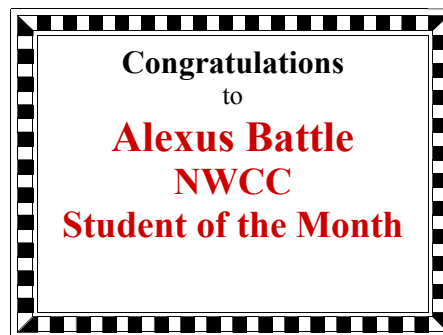

FAFSA Priority Filing Date – March 1st

Housing Deposit – May 1st

Park University

April 1, 2014 is the financial aid priority deadline, but applications will be accepted on a rolling basis after that date.

Admissions applications accepted on a rolling basis until classes begin.

Housing applications accepted on a rolling basis while space is available

Southeast Missouri State University (SEMO)

November 1 – Recommended application date for students wishing to meet the priority housing deadline of December 15. This does not guarantee choice of housing.

December 15 – Early admission consideration and scholarship guarantee deadline

February 15 – Recommended FAFSA completion date for students wishing to meet the March 1 priority processing deadline

March 1 – Final deadline for merit, student involvement and endowed scholarships

June 1 – Fall 2011 application deadline for students required to live in on-campus housing. Applications will continue to be accepted past June 1 for commuter students.
