

After a short break the Benton County R-2 School District board members continued the meeting in executive session on March 19, 2018 beginning at 8:54 P.M. Board members present were Mehrens, Kroenke, Beaman, Parrott, Ebeling, Eichler and Yearout.

Kevin Smith, Marc Spunaugle, Becky Eifert, and Michelle Smith were also present.

Elementary principal Becky Eifert reported on Sheryl Jarrett evaluation and recommends a tenure teacher contract be offered to Sheryl Jarrett. After discussion a motion was made by Beaman, seconded by Yearout to offer a tenure teacher contracts to Sheryl Jarrett for the 2018-2019 school year. The Teachers for Consideration for 2018-2019 Contracts List was given to board members. The probationary elementary, special education, and secondary teachers were considered for 2018-2019 contracts. The respective principals reported on the individual teacher evaluations and answered questions presented concerning the individuals listed. After discussion a motion was made by Parrott, seconded by Eichler to offer probationary teacher contracts for the 2018-2019 school year to Jonna Arnett, Lauren Collins, Jennifer Eckers, Travis Goosen, Kristin Monnig, Amy Smith, Tyler Burke, Margaret Cook, Laurel Larimore, Kevin LaFavor, Emily McCullough, and Kelly Robey. Roll call vote of motion carried as follows: Yearout-yes; Eichler-yes; Ebeling-yes; Parrott-yes; Beaman-yes; Kroenke-yes; and Mehrens-yes. Motion carried 7 yes, 0 no.

Mr. Smith shared that extra duty/coaching contracts will be discussed at the April board meeting. Also, shared the open positions for Industrial Arts High School, Elementary / High School Art, and Special Education. Also mentioned are changes that will be made to bus routes to be approved at the June meeting.
