Student Transfer Online Application - January 4th - February 26th

The application period for all student transfers for the Mobile County Public School System began January 4, 2021. An application is required for students who wish to enroll outside of their attendance zone. Once the transfer is approved, it is valid through the school's exit grade unless the transfer is revoked. The only form to be completed is for new transfer applicants only. The process will be electronic, parents will complete and submit the application ONLINE at www.mcpss.com, then CLICK the APPLY FOR icon (looks like paper and pencil) and click on Student/School Choice Transfers.
