

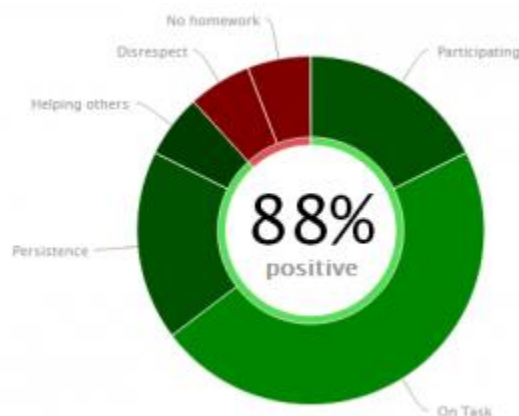
First Grade Class Dojo/Behavior Management Information

Our goal for the students is to provide ongoing, direct reinforcement for behavior (positive and negative). We will teach the students the difference between good and bad choices and provide consistent reinforcement throughout the day.

Class Dojo

You can log in to classdojo.com or download the Class Dojo app to view your child's daily, weekly, or monthly behavior reports. While Class Dojo provides valuable insight into your child's day, we encourage you to not overthink the information provided.

If we have concerns about your child's behavior, we will contact you and discuss it directly. You will be given your specific class code and directions on how to join by your child's teacher!



Color Chart

Each day, your child will come home with a color marked in his or her folder. Please look at this and initial if your child was on yellow, orange, or red and the specific information on why your child clipped down will be on Class Dojo. You can just initial on Friday if your child stayed on green, blue, purple, or pink all week. When the kids know that the parents and teachers communicate about behavior, they better understand the consequences of their choices at school. We encourage you to discuss your child's color each day and have a set of rewards and consequences at home that coordinate with the colors. For example, a blue day earns 10 extra minutes of iPad time, or a purple day earns a special story at bedtime. The children will respond better to the behavior system when it is consistent at home and at school.

- Every morning your child starts on green.
- The children have a chance to move up and down the chart during the day.
- Our colors correspond to the number of Dojo points earned:
 - 4+ = Red
 - 2,-3 = Orange
 - 1 = Yellow
 - 0,1 = Green
 - 2-4 = Blue
 - 5-6 = Purple
 - 7+ = Pink

*Children that stayed on green or higher all week will participate in Fun Friday. Students that had a yellow or orange during that week will be given a short timeout. Children with a red that week will not participate.

*3 oranges or 1 red will result in a "write up" which is the start of an office referral. Once a child has 3 "write ups" in a nine weeks, the office referral is then turned in to administration.
