Parent Responsibilities

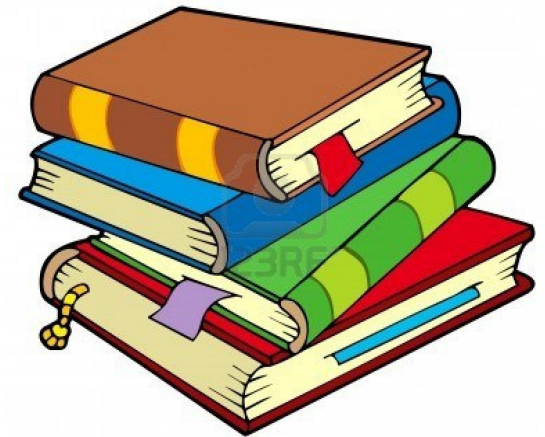
We, as parents, will:
