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


Print, laminate and cut out the game card and corresponding poem.

Make the crocodile container using an empty cascade detergent container. Patterns are available on makinglearningfun.com

Place the cards inside the crocodile.

Children will sit in a circle and take turns passing around the container, pulling out a letter, and saying the name or letter sound. When the answer is correct, the letter goes in the center of the circle. If they are incorrect, they can "phone a friend" for help! If a child pulls out a "SNAP" card, children put their arms out like a crocodile and say "SNAP!" and all of the cards go back into the crocodile and play continues.
