The Fannin County Board of Education met in a work session with the following members present: Sandra Mercier, Chair; Steve Stanley, Vice-Chair; Bobby Bearden; Terry Bramlett; and Lewis DeWeese. All members present.

Art Hubbard, Assistant Superintendent, gave Board members an update on the field house construction project. Mr. Hubbard stated the following items were completed on the field house project: 1) the interior plumbing trim was 90% complete; 2) the HVAC systems were operational; 3) the electrical trim is 75% complete; 4) the interior walls have been painted; 5) the locker installation is complete; 6) the suspended ceiling grid installation is complete; 7) the exterior door installation is complete; 8) the interior door installation is 50% complete; 9) the gutter drainage system is complete; 10) awaiting satisfactory moisture test to install epoxy floors; and 11) the vinyl composite tile installation is scheduled to start next week.

Mr. Henson reviewed the agenda for the meeting on Thursday, April 12, 2012.

Mr. Henson stated the Georgia Department of Education released the 2010 – 2011 Georgia high school graduation rates and Fannin County's rate was 82.18%. Mr. Henson also stated the state average was 67.4%. Mr. Henson stated Georgia used the newly implemented four-year adjusted cohort graduation federal formula to calculate these percentages.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, upon motion duly made, seconded, and carried, the meeting adjourned subject to being called into special session by the Chair when deemed necessary.
