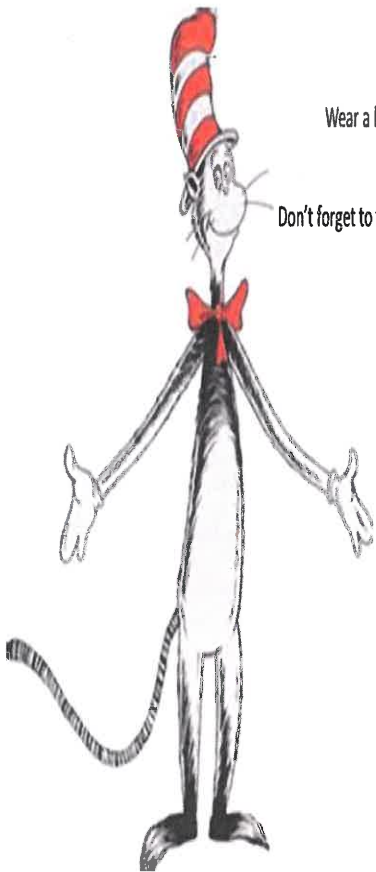
### Dr. Seuss Birthday Celebration
