

Dear Academy Applicant:

Thank you for your interest into the Pike County Schools Academy Program. The mission of the Academy Program is to prepare high school students to compete in the workforce of the 21<sup>st</sup> Century and prepare them to enter the nation's best colleges and universities.

Please read this entire letter before completing the Academy Application – there is important and useful information included. In order to apply to Pike County Schools Academy Program, you must have an overall grade point average of 3.0, good attendance, and appropriate behavior. For the Business and Finance Academy, applicants must have passed Accounting I with a "B" average or do so during the first year in the academy. All students wishing to participate in one of the various academy programs must take either the ACT (English 18-20/ Math 18-22, depending on academy choice) or the ACCUPLACER – college readiness exam (Reading, Language, Mathematics) with scores qualifying for English Composition I (ENG 101) and Intermediate College Algebra (MTH 100/1105). If you have not taken the ACT or ACCUPLACER, you will be given an opportunity to do so following the close of the Academy Application process – see the included flyer for information in preparation for the ACCUPLACER placement test.

The application process is a fairly simple one. All forms needed are contained within this packet. Please have all information together and return to your school counselor. Completed Teacher and Administrator - Student Rating Forms should be submitted, by the teacher and/or administrator, directly to the school counselor.

All applicants will be required to participate in an interview process that will help us to refine which candidates will move forward in the academy selection process. Students applying for the First in Flight and Leadership Academy will participate in an additional interview with pilots and/or flight instructors from our partner, SkyWarrior - These will be scheduled following the initial interviews.

We will accept up to 10 new academy members to each academy cohort. Keep in mind that our committee will use Teacher and Administrator Student Rating Forms, grades, attendance,



and discipline records to determine final eligibility for academy placement. In addition, academy students will likely be required to participate in on-line courses at various times throughout their academy program. Finally, we encourage students to participate in extracurricular activities. However, understand that academy programs are challenging and the scheduling of classes sometimes conflicts with various activities. We do our best to be flexible, but academic responsibilities are an academy student's first priority.

As a member of the Pike Count	ty Schoo	ols Academy Progra	am, I understand that:					

- I am making a commitment to a full academy program which I have selected (2 or 3-year program depending on academy). These programs are a combination of dual enrollment courses (on-line and traditional), traditional high school and career technical courses, and possibly on-line high school instruction.
- 2. For programs requiring internship, prior to beginning internship, I must:
  - a. Successfully complete all courses through the end of my junior year,
  - b. Achieve excellent record of attendance and punctuality; and
  - c. Provide my Social Security Number, proof of citizenship, and fingerprints, if necessary.
- 3. I understand that while taking college courses (on-line, dual, or weekend) classes, if I fail to earn a "C" or higher in a class, I will have two options: 1) I will be taken out of the academy, or 2) if I choose to stay in the academy, I (my parents) will be responsible for all tuition, books, fees, registration, etc. for the remaining semesters that I am enrolled in the academy.
- 4. I understand that any history of drug use or criminal conviction will jeopardize my participation in the academy program and/or my required internship.
- 5. I understand that I may be required to participate in service activities and log a minimum of 60 hours academy specific, as required.
- 6. By signing this memorandum, my legal guardian gives me permission to attend classes, take trips with my class, report for job interviews, and travel to work for my summer internship.
- 7. I must be dressed appropriately when reporting for academy activities, classes, job interviews, and work (must follow the Pike County Schools Dress Code).
- 8. When placed in an internship, I am responsible for whatever tasks I am assigned by my supervisor.
- 9. I understand that there will be a special notation entered on my permanent record and school transcript regarding my participation in the academy program.
- 10. I understand that I will be required to join various organizations (i.e., Future Farmers of America, Future Business Leaders of America, etc.) as part of my participation in the academy programs.
- 11. I understand that I will be required to obtain certain clothing for professional and academy dress.
- 12. If I have any questions or problems with regard to any aspect of the academy program, I will contact the director/facilitator of my academy.



- 13. Academic misconduct by students includes all acts of dishonesty in any academically related matter and any knowing or intentional help or attempt to help, or conspiracy to help, another student commit an act of academic dishonesty. The Pike County School System reserves the right to institute consequences in addition to those imposed by the post-secondary institution or curriculum provider (i.e, ACCESS, direct computer-based instructional system, etc.) involved, which may include but is not limited to dismissal from academic and/or dual enrollment programs. **At a minimum, students will receive zeros for the impacted assignments**. Academic dishonesty includes, but is not limited to, each of the following acts when performed in any type of academic or academically related matter, exercise, or activity; including both high school and post-secondary institution, whether on-line, face-to-face, or hybrid.
  - a. Cheating--using or attempting to use unauthorized materials, information, study aids, or computer-related information.
  - b. Plagiarism--representing the words, data, pictures, figures, works, ideas, computer program or output, or anything not generated in an authorized fashion, as one's own.
  - c. Fabrication--presenting as genuine any invented or falsified citation or material.
  - d. Misrepresentation--falsifying, altering, or misstating the contents of documents or other materials related to academic matters, including schedules, prerequisites, and transcripts
- 14. I agree to engage in appropriate academic and social behavior that is consistent with the expectation of a Pike County Academy Student, which includes:
  - a. Maintaining an overall 3.0 GPA, with all grades being a "C" or higher. This is an on-going requirement for this program.
  - b. Attend both high school and college classes, as scheduled.
    - i. Academy students are subject to all policies and procedures for students within the Pike County School System, including attendance.
    - ii. Academy students may be denied high school credit as a result of a violation to the attendance policy.
    - iii. College credits are subject to the post-secondary partners' attendance policy.
  - c. Violations to the Code of Conduct.
    - i. Academy students are subject to all policies and procedures for students within the Pike County School System, including the Code of Conduct.
    - ii. Academy students must adhere to the disciplinary procedures established by the postsecondary partner, both on-line and face-to-face (as appropriate).
    - iii. Academy students are expected to conduct themselves with discipline and respect; this includes adhering to local, state, and federal laws.



- d. Misuse of technology, including social media.
  - i. Use of technology to view and/or distribute explicit material is strictly prohibited.
  - Use of social media that represents the student, other students, the academy program, and/or the Pike County School System in an unflattering or negative manner is strictly prohibited.
  - iii. Engaging in disruptive and/or inappropriate behavior of any sort via social media or other electronic media is strictly prohibited and will not be tolerated.
  - iv. This includes activities before, during, and after school hours; both personal and school owned electronic devices.

Failure to sign this agreement automatically excludes students from participating in the academy program. This program is a privilege afforded to select students of the Pike County School System. Failure to adhere to these standards may result in dismissal from the academy program. All academy students must have a signed copy of this document on-file in their academy folder prior to participation in dual enrollment classes.

In conclusion, I understand that by being accepted into this program I am committing myself to work during the summer to fulfill my internship requirements and/or other course work, as necessary. My acceptance further commits me to be an academy participant from this time forward, until graduation or until such time as I no longer meet the requirements of the academy program. Participation in the Academy Program will be reviewed periodically to ensure adherence to all established policies and procedures.
