Breckinridge County High School 2019 Accountability Results



The 2019 Kentucky Performance Rating for Educational Progress (KPREP) Results have been released today. BCHS scored well enough to be rated as a three star school on a five star scale. BCHS KPREP results for the 2019 school year may be accessed at the following web address http://www.kyschoolreportcard.com.

BCHS was rated medium in proficiency. Proficiency is defined as reaching the desired level of knowledge and skills as measured on state-required academic assessments. It is designed to measure how students achieve on Kentucky's Academic Standards in reading and mathematics.

BCHS received a rating of high in Separate Academic. The Separate Academic Indicator is determined by reaching the desired level of knowledge and skills in science and writing in high school.

BCHS received a rating of medium in Transition Readiness. To be transition ready, high school students must earn a high school diploma and meet one type of readiness (i.e., academic or career), while English learners must attain English language proficiency.

BCHS received a rating of low in Graduation Rate. Graduation rate is the percentage of students earning a high school diploma in four and five years compared to the group of students that began in high school in grade 9. Kentucky's graduation rate indicator averages the four- and five-year rates. The calculation is based on the student's final enrollment.
