What is a reflexive pronoun?

A reflexive pronoun is used when the direct object in a sentence refers back to the subject of the sentence. It is used when something (or someone) does something to itself.

If you're talking about a group you're a part of, you can say "ourselves"



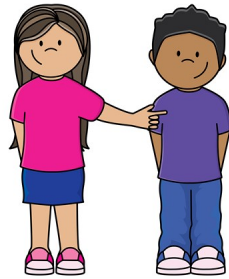
If you're talking to another person, you can say "yourself"

If you're talking about an object, you can say "itself"



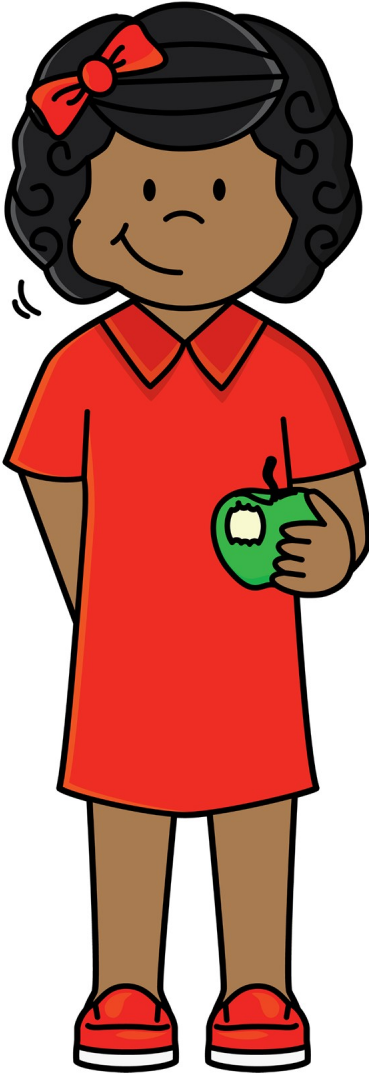
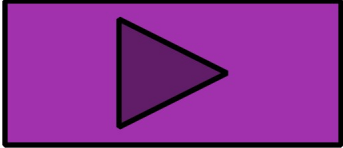
